


CENTRAL VISAYAS 17 watersheds

Total Area: 367,241 has.

Watershed is an area where water drains down from its tributaries and accumulates into a common outlet such as dams, oceans or lakes.

To manage all surface and ground water resources to ensure the sustainable water supply, on July 20, 2011, Central Cebu River Basins Management Council (CCRBMC) was created. It covers 5 cities and 6 municipalities and is composed of 4 watersheds/river basins covering a total area of 68,133 hectares.



PRIORITY PROGRAMS and MAJOR ACCOMPLISHMENTS

1. CLEAN AIR

Based on the results, ambient air quality is in "GOOD" condition for PM10 concentration and "FAIR" condition for TSP concentration as stipulated in Annex A of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the Philippine Clean Air Act of 1999 (RA 8749).



5 Air Quality Monitoring Station

A steady improvement in ambient air quality was realized in pollution level in terms of total suspended particulate (tsp) concentration. This means that our efforts such as capacity building to our partner stakeholders, comprehensive IEC, intensive monitoring and inspection, and implementation of airshed action plan are contributing to improving the air quality in Metro Cebu.

2. CLEAN WATER

The program is implemented based on the established environmental laws specifically RA 9275, the Philippine Clean Water Act (CWA) that provides for a comprehensive strategy to address the degradation of our waterbodies. The program aims to improve water quality of Priority Rivers and other critical water bodies including lakes and bays through continuous massive clean-up, monitoring of industries and rehabilitation of esteros/rivers through partnership agreements such as the Adopt-an-estero program.

3. SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT

The ecological solid waste management program is expected to assist Local Government Units in implementing RA 9003 or the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act particularly in the development of their 10 yr. SWM Plan, closure and rehabilitation of dumpsites, establishment of Materials Recovery Facilities, and an environmentally sound disposal system.

III. Full Closure of all 27 Dumpsites and signing of MOA between the LGUs and SLF operators and First Quarter Cleanup

In compliance with the directive of DENR Secretary Roy A. Cimatu, all 27 operational dumpsites in 26 LGUs within R7 were closed.





The section also saw the fruition of its efforts in February as out of these 26 LGUs, 10 are now disposing to a sanitary landfill while the remaining 16 are making use of RCAs

Of the remaining 16, nine are on the process of finalizing an agreement to dispose to existing SLFs or are planning to establish their own SLF.

V. Completion of the Design and Estimates of the Category 4 SLF and formal turnover to LGU Daanbantayan, Cebu



On October, the Design and Estimates of a Category 4 Sanitary Landfill was finally completed by the EnMO Civil Engineers. The turnover was done in a formal event attended by the EMB Director Engr. William P. Cuñado, EMB Assistant Director Vizminda A. Osorio, EMB7 Regional Director Lormelyn E. Claudio, Mayor Sun Shimura and Mr. Mamerto Rodrigo of LGU Daanbantayan, Cebu.




4. GEOHAZARD, GROUNDWATER ASSESSMENT AND RESPONSIBLE MINING

This program intends to capacitate communities to their adaptation to geologic hazards, as well as provide them critical data on groundwater resources.


PRODUCTION OF BAMBOO PLANTING STOCKS








Map of MMFN, SPAs, SSO and IPTs in Region 7
